
CABLED SEDONA PUMPKIN







SIZING

The finished pumpkin has a 25" circumference and is 7" tall.

MATERIALS

YARN

200 yards of Red Heart Hello Gorgeous in Sedona

NEEDLES

US #8/5.00 mm dpn

NOTIONS

cable needle fiber fill finishing needle stick (for stem) stitch markers

GAUGE

17 sts x 23 rows = 4" x 4" in Stockinette stitch

The colors and cables in this pattern add a fun twist to the traditional autumn pumpkin. Choose a colorway that matches your home or adds a pop of fall flavor!

PATTERN

The pumpkin is worked from top to bottom in the round. It is a large, stuffed donut shape.

ABBREVIATIONS

BO - bind off

CN - cable needle

CO - cast on

k - knit

m - marker

p - purl

PM - place marker

sl - slip

C4F - cable 4 front

sl 2 sts onto CN and hold in front, k2, k2 from CN

C6B - cable 6 back

sl 3 sts onto CN and hold in back, k3, k3 from CN

C6F - cable 6 front

sl 3 sts onto CN and hold in front, k3, k3 from CN

SETUP

CO 84 sts and join in the round, taking care not to twist. k 1 round.

BODY

The body is worked in a 24-round pattern. When asked to work stitches as they present, knit stitches should be knit and purl stitches should be purled.

1 - *p3, k9, p3, k6, p3, k4* 13 - work stitches as they present 2 - work stitches as they present 14 - work stitches as they present 3 - *p3, C6F, k3, p3, k6, p3, k4* 15 - *p3, k3, C6B, p3, k6, p3, k4* 4 - work stitches as they present 16 - work stitches as they present 5 - *p3, k9, p3, k6, p3, C4F* 17 - *p3, k9, p3, k6, p3, C4F* 6 - work stitches as they present 18 - work stitches as they present 7 - *p3, k3, C6B, p3, k6, p3, k4* 19 - *p3, C6F, k3, p3, k6, p3, k4* 20 - work stitches as they present 8 - work stitches as they present 9 - work stitches as they present 21 - work stitches as they present 10 - work stitches as they present 22 - work stitches as they present 11 - *p3, C6F, k3, p3, k6, p3, C4F* 23 - *p3, k3, C6B, p3, k6, C4F* 24 - work stitches as they present 12 - work stitches as they present

Work these 24 rounds three times total (72 rounds). k 1 round and BO.

FINISHING

Cut a length of orange yarn from the skein and work a duplicate stitch up the center of the St st panel.

Fold the pumpkin with the right side out and match the top of each cable to the bottom. Stitch together, leaving a hole about 4" wide. Stuff the pumpkin and squeeze to plump. Sew 4" seam closed and weave in end.

Turn pumpkin so that the seam is not visible. Insert stick into center; it should stay upright without securing.

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
