BROKEN SEED STITCH COWL

A Sampler Cowl Knitting Pattern by Holly Beemer



Scraps of yarn can be turned into a stunning cowl! The simple stitch is easy to master and uses contrast highlight the beauty of each yarn.

Finished Size

8" x 28"

Materials

Yarn scrap yarn in 6 colorways ~3 yards per round (varies by weight)

> Berroco Mochi in Vanilla (Color A) Berroco Tiramisu in Tartufo (Color B) Berroco Millefiori Light Luxe in Aquamarine (Color C) Berroco Artesia in Camellia (Color D) Berroco Aerial in Tea Rose (Color E), doubled Berroco Lanas in Lake (Color F)



16 sts x 30 rows = 4" x 4" in Broken Seed Stitch Gauge

Gauge will vary based on yarns used.

- Needles US #10/6.00 mm (16" circular)
- Notions finishing needle stitch markers

Abbreviations

BO - bind off CO - cast on k - knit kwise - knitwise p - purl pm - place marker st(s) - stitch(es)

Broken Seed Stitch

Round 1 - k all Round 2 - *k1, p1* Round 3 - k all Round 4 - *p1, k1*

Setup

CO 120 sts with Color A, pm, and join in the round, taking care not to twist.

Body

Following the color chart provided below, work in Broken Seed Stitch until the cowl reaches the desired length.

After the last 4-round repeat of Broken Seed Stitch, BO all sts kwise (using the same color as Round 4).

Color Chart

Each 4-round repeat will be worked with 2 colors. You will use 1 color per round.

After 4 rounds, you will continue to use 1 of the 2 colors. The other color will change.

Rounds 21 - 24	Color C Color E Color C Color E	Rounds 49 - 52	Color A Color B Color A Color B
Rounds 25 - 28	Color D Color E Color D		

Finishing

Weave in all ends. Block lightly if desired.
