
MOSAIC GRATITUDE SCARF

A Slipped Stitch Scarf Knitting Pattern by Holly Beemer





Bold detail in colors that pop, yet still simple to knit! This project was designed with **Operation Gratitude** in mind.

SIZE

48" long by 5" wide

GAUGE

12 sts x 18 rows = 4" x 4" in garter stitch

MATERIALS

YARN

125 yards of Impeccable Loops & Threads yarn in Deep Forest (Color A) 50 yards of Impeccable Loops & Threads in *Forest* (Color B)

NEEDLES

US #9/5.50 mm circular (36" or larger)

NOTIONS

finishing needle

ABBREVIATIONS

BO - bind off CO - cast on gs - garter stitch k - knit RS - right side sl - slip st(s) - stitch(es) WS - wrong side

NOTES

The Mosaic Gratitude Scarf is worked back and forth down the length of the scarf.

Mosaic designs are knit by alternating colors at the end of every other row. You will only work with one yarn at a time.

Carry your yarn up the side of your work rather than cutting the yarn after every two rows.

When slipping stitches, slip RS stitches with yarn in back and slip WS stitches with yarn in front.

PATTERN

SETUP

With Color A and size #9 needles, CO 195 sts.

Knit 1 row.

MOSAIC

Row 1 (RS, Color B) - k1 *sl1, k11* to last 2 sts, sl1, k1

Row 2 and all even rows - knit all stitches that were knit on the last row and slip all stitches that were slipped on the last row

Row 3 (Color A) - k4 *(sl1, k1) 3 times, sl1, k5* to last 11 sts, (sl1, k1) 3 times, sl1, k4

Row 5 (Color B) - k3 *sl1, k7, sl1, k3*

Row 7 (Color A) - k2 *sl1, k3, sl1, k1* to the last st, k1

Row 9 (Color B) - k5 *sl1, k3, sl1, k7* to last 10 sts, sl1, k3, sl1, k5

Row 11 (Color A) - k2 *sl1, k1, sl1, k5, (sl1, k1) 2 times* to last st, k1

Row 13 (Color B) - k7 *sl1, k11* to last 8 sts, sl1, k7



BODY

Change to Color A and work in gs until scarf reaches 5" or desired width.

FINISHING

BO all sts. Weave in ends. Block if desired.

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
