

SANGUINE HAT

A Textured Cap Knitting Pattern by Holly Beemer

at yarn's length



SIZING

23" circumference
8.5" height

MATERIALS

YARN

1 skein of AdriaFil Stellato in 52 *Ruby*
or
165 yards of aran weight yarn

NEEDLES

US #6/4.00mm
US #8/5.00mm
circular or dpn recommended

NOTIONS

finishing needle
pom-pom (optional)
stitch markers

GAUGE

16 sts x 20 rows = 4" x 4"
in Stockinette stitch

The Sanguine hat is stretchy and sparkly with all-over texture, topped with a fiery pom-pom. The stitch pattern provides all-over texture and is simple to commit to memory.

PATTERN

The cap is worked in the round from the brim up.

ABBREVIATIONS

BO - bind off
CO - cast on
k - knit
k2tog - knit 2 stitches together; single right-leaning decrease
p - purl
pm - place marker
p2tog - purl 2 stitches together; single stitch decrease
st(s) - stitch(es)

SETUP

With US #6/4.00mm needles, CO 96 sts, pm, and join for working in the round, taking care not to twist.

BRIM

Round 1 - *k1, p1*

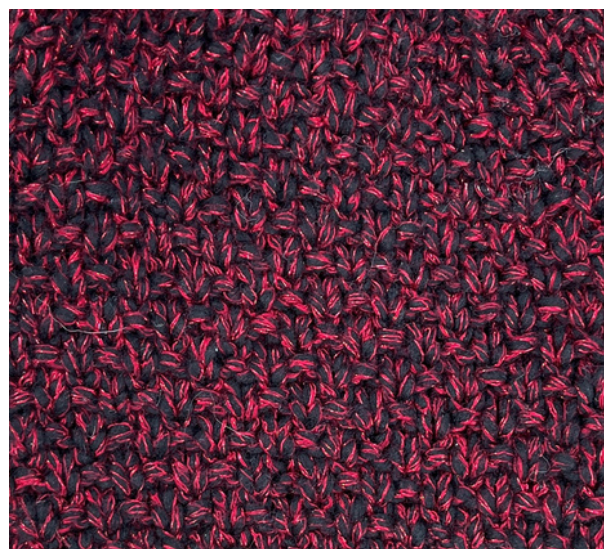
Continue to work in k1, p1 rib until brim measures 3" from cast-on edge.

BODY

Change to US #8/5.00mm needles and work the body as follows:

Round 1 - k all
Round 2 - *k1, p1*
Round 3 - k all
Round 4 - *p1, k1*

Repeat these 4 rounds until your work measures 7" from the cast-on edge, ending with the completion of Round 4.



CROWN SHAPING

Round 1 - *k24, pm*
Round 2 - *p2tog, (k1, p1) until 2 sts before m, k2tog, slip m*
Round 3 - k all

Repeat Rounds 2 and 3 until 12 sts remain (2 sts per section).

FINISHING

Snip yarn, leaving a long tail. Draw through remaining stitches, pull tight, and secure.

Weave in ends.
Add pompom and block, if desired.

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
