FOOLISH MORTALS PILLOW





The Foolish Mortals Pillow Cover knitting pattern is a must-knit for any Haunted Mansion fan! It was inspired by the iconic wallpaper.

Materials

Yarn 2 skeins of Baby Bee Sweet Delight in *Grape Jelly*

(or Patons Canadiana in *Grape Jelly*)

1 skein of Baby Bee Sweet Delight in Soft Licorice

(or Patons Canadiana in *Black*)

Gauge 23 sts x 26 rows = 4" x 4"

in Stockinette stitch (DK)

Needles US #8/5.00 mm DPN

Notions finishing needle

stitch markers

Finished Size

16" x 16"

Abbreviations

BO - bind off

CC - contrasting color

CO - cast on

k - knit

MC - main color

p - purl

RS - right side

st(s) - stitch(es)

St st - Stockinette stitch



Pattern Notes

Both versions of this pillow cover are worked back and forth from the bottom up. For both versions, the front and back are worked separately and seamed together.

The chart for each version is very detailed. Bold lines mark the stitches and rows by groups of 10. Stitch markers are not required, but are <u>very</u> helpful in keeping your place while working.



Front

CO 90 sts in MC. Work back and forth in St st, following one of the charts below. Slip the first stitch of each row for easy seaming later.

Back

CO 90 sts in MC. Work back and forth in St st for 104 rows, then BO all sts.

Finishing

Line up the front and back of the pillow cover. Seam the top and both sides, then insert pillow and seam the bottom. Weave in ends.
